
- The number of members in good standing and entitled to vote on matters reported below at the Annual Meeting was 1451.
- In accordance with the Bylaws, no quorum of members was required to elect Directors.
- I reviewed the registration and all ballots received.
- I received 230 valid, signed ballot return envelopes.
- I received three (3) additional ballot return envelopes that were unsigned and therefore invalid.
- I determined the authenticity, validity and effect of each of the ballots.
- I determined all challenges and questions in anyway arising in connection with the right to vote.
- The one (1) candidate receiving the highest number of votes will be elected for a three (3) year term. Votes were tabulated as follows:
