ELECTION OF DIRECTORS**


I, Lisa Schwartz, the duly appointed Inspector of Election at the Annual Meeting of the Stonelake Master Association, a California, nonprofit, Mutual-Benefit Corporation, held on March 10, 2020, do hereby report as follows:

- The number of members in good standing and entitled to vote on matters reported below at the Annual Meeting was 1467.
- In accordance with the Bylaws, no quorum of members was required to elect Directors.
- I reviewed the registration and all ballots received.
- A total of 239 valid, signed ballot envelopes were received containing 239 ballots.
- One (1) additional envelope was received unsigned and was therefore invalid.
- Three (3) ballots were deposited in the on-site ballot box in only the secret ballot envelope and were therefore invalid.
- I determined the authenticity, validity and effect of each of the ballots.
- I determined all challenges and questions in anyway arising in connection with the right to vote.
- The two (2) candidates receiving the highest number of votes will be elected for a three (3) year term. Votes were tabulated as follows:
